



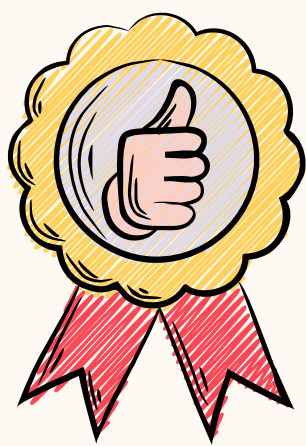
My Dear LSPS Students,

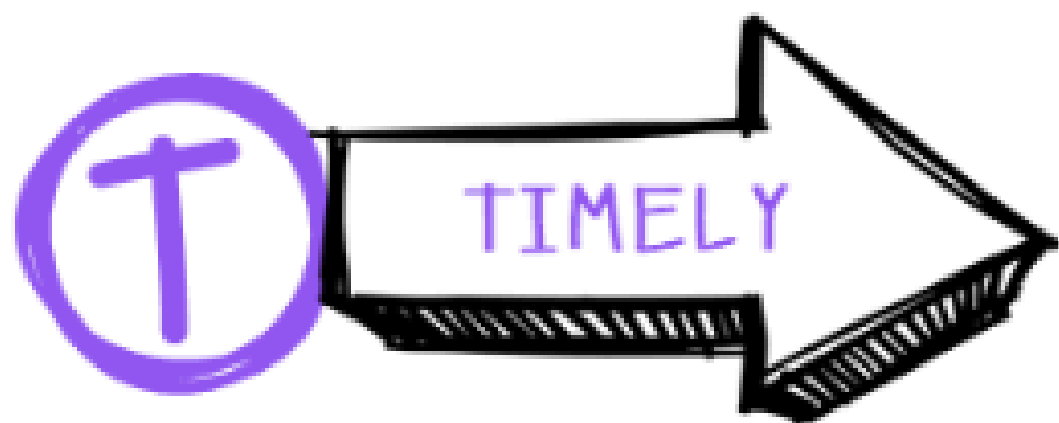
How will you know when you meet your goal?

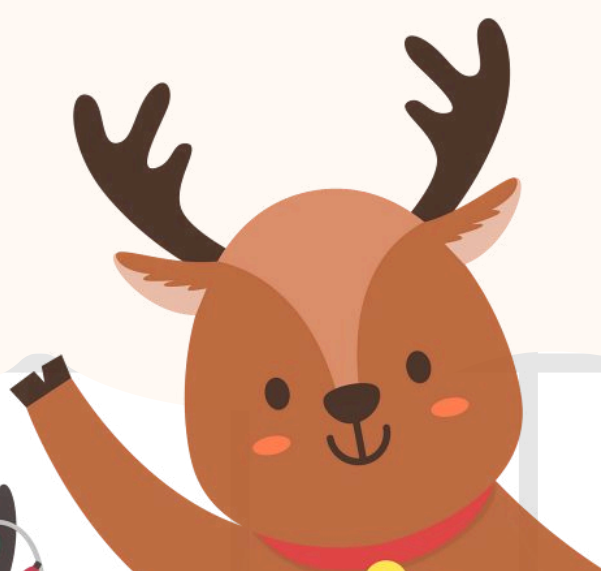
