Easter is the most sacred feast of the Catholic Church. It celebrates the Resurrection of Jesus Christ, the Son of God, who conquered sin and death and opened the way to eternal life. Easter Sunday always falls in spring, though the date shifts each year, occurring between 22nd March and 25th April.

The celebration of Easter is prepared for by the season of Lent, a time of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. Lent recalls the forty days Jesus spent fasting in the desert, and it begins on Ash Wednesday, when the faithful receive ashes on their foreheads as a sign of repentance and renewal.

The final days of Lent are known as Holy Week, when Catholics prayerfully remember the Passion of Christ. Palm Sunday recalls His triumphant entry into Jerusalem. Holy Thursday, also called Maundy Thursday, commemorates the Last Supper, when Jesus instituted the Eucharist and the priesthood. Good Friday solemnly remembers His crucifixion and death on the cross. On Easter Sunday, the Church proclaims with joy that Christ is risen, fulfilling His promise of salvation.

Catholics mark Easter with the celebration of the Mass, the highest form of worship, where the Resurrection is proclaimed and the faithful receive the Eucharist. Alongside these sacred traditions, many cultures also observe joyful customs such as decorating eggs and celebrating with family meals. Symbols like eggs and rabbits remind us of new life, but for Catholics, Easter above all is the victory of Christ and the renewal of our faith.

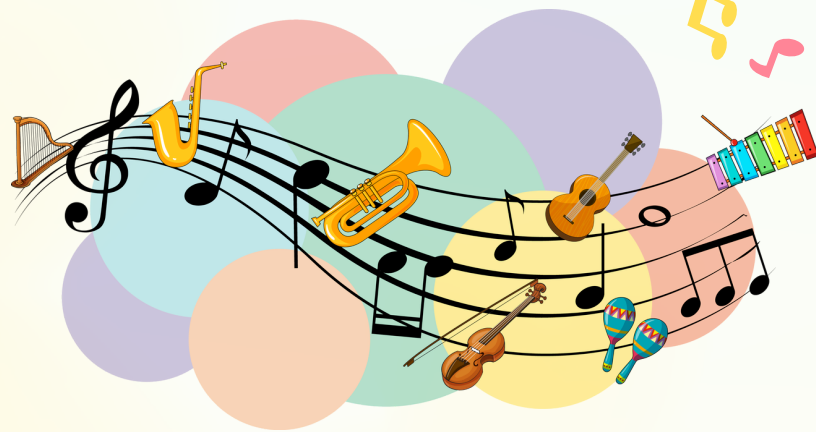
