several weeks of summer fun.**

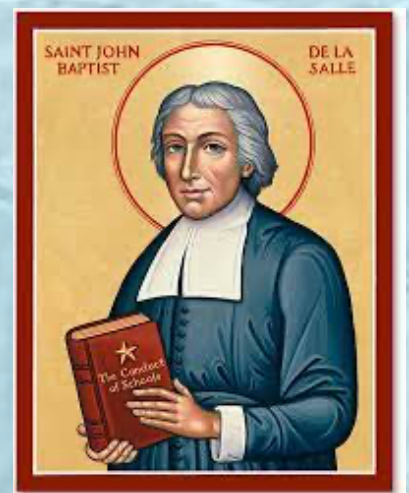
**Now as my studies begin,
